Dear Aaron,

I am contacting you today regarding the OSGeo Cascadia Chapter's potential interest in hosting the Free and Open Source Software for Geospatial Annual Conference in Sept/Oct 2011.

I have been in direct contact with Jeff McKenna, who recommended that I partner with a Local Organizing Committee in order to secure a planning assistance role for the event.

If your LOC is interested in hosting FOSS4G, I would like to propose that you include ConferenceDirect as your Professional Meeting Planning partner in order to create a more compelling case at the "Letter of Intent" stage, and subsequent "Bid Submission" stage of this process.

If the Fall 2011 FOSS4G Conference is awarded to your Local Organizing Committee, the first order of business should be to secure the <u>venue</u>. Here is where I can help you <u>at NO cost</u> to your LOC: ConferenceDirect's buying power <u>in Seattle</u> is substantial. ConferenceDirect could enhance your efforts – allowing you to focus on <u>creating the conference content</u>, while enlisting my help to secure the actual venue, and ensure your best value.
