These institutions have developed scientific research on topics related to the conservation of this region, which is so important for the world, contributing to the regulation of the global climate and for harboring the greatest biodiversity on the planet. In addition to these university research centers, the Instituto de Pesquisa Ambiental da Amazônia (IPAM) and the Museu Paraense Emílio Goeldi contribute to research in the region and are international references in this thematic.

With the return of Brazil to the scenario of the global discussion about environmental sustainability, and holding of COP-30, Belém will be an important center of convergence of attention from the whole world to the Northern Region of Brazil. The holding of the FOSS4G 2024 Conference, in Belém, will be able to contribute with free and open geospatial technologies, for the instrumentalization of research on the Amazon and other fundamental Biomes, located in Brazil and in the world. In addition to contributing to the understanding of the existing geospatial dynamics in this valued region.



So, we believe that having the global FOSS4G in Belém, Brazil, is a great opportunity to empower FOSS4G in Latin America and, also, strengthen the FOSS4G users and developers network by amplifying the knowledge and contacts among stakeholders who can't afford traveling to others continents for such an event. Also, it would bring much more attention to the use and development of FOSS in South America, not to mention in the Amazonian region.
