Conferences

• FOSS4G 2025 global conference

- Auckland is on the second round, preparing a full proposal
- FOSS4G SotM Oceania 2024
 - Venue deposit 14k within conference budget
 - MOTION: approve this expenditure, all agreed
 - Conference oversight: proposal to request the conference committee provide finance tracking sheet to compare the budget forecasts with current income and expenses
 - all agreed, conf committee is requested to provide an updated version of this for each board meeting
 - Last year's conference ticket sales were a large part of shortfall this year, need to focus on promotion, ticket sales
 - Open regos soon? Aiming for May
 - Comms support needed CWG can support (following lead of LOC)

Finance

- March 2024 Management Report link
- venue deposit \$14k
- Outstanding 2023 NZ GST
 - background:
 - In 2023, we collected AUD ~\$7k in NZ GST, possibly roughly similar level of GST paid, may come close to balancing out
 - We haven't registered, filed, or remitted may be liable for penalties
 - Have been advised by a NZ accountant (via Elisa's colleague) that we need to contact IRD and retrospectively register for GST
 - need a person with an IRD # to be our IRD contact; requires a RealID, must be a current director
 - Elisa has RealID, but wants help with it
 - Do current accountants (macquarie) have a NZ branch? No.
 - We received <u>advice from Macquarie</u> in 2019, but noted they are not qualified to give NZ tax advice
 - Over the next week, John and Elisa will review our options. If these options don't show us a clear pathway to a resolution, an accountant will be engaged.
 - ACTION: John & Elisa to review options within 7 days and look for a clear pathway to resolving NZ GST

Elections

- Constitution 79.1: "Prior to the completion of each financial year, the Board shall lay out a process for electing new directors to the board, such process to be distributed to members."
- We need to lay out the process by 30 June ACTION: Renee to review the election process to see if it needs to be modified
- Cancellation of members who do not vote in two consecutive elections.
 - Under the <u>Membership policy</u> it states
 - Members have the right and responsibility to vote in annual board elections (which can be done electronically). Members not meeting this responsibility in two

consecutive annual elections will be assumed to be inactive, and removed from the membership register, with thanks for their prior service.

- \circ $\:$ In the 2020 election 76 did not vote and one invalid email
- No elections occurred in 2021 and 2022
- In the 2023 election 133 did not vote and 12 email addresses were invalid
- 44 members did not vote in 2020 and 2023 election and should be struck off
- \circ $\;$ We have the possibility of a significant number of members struck off next year $\;$
- ACTION: Ewen to follow up membership discussion by Loomio, for discussion at next board meeting

NFP income tax exempt status - lodgement required

- We need to start lodging annual self-review returns this year, info here
- Lodge via ATO online services between July-October for 2023-2024 tax year
