This 4th edition will highlight different themes. The committee will favor the presentations pertaining to applied geomatics.

Potential themes : agriculture, climate change, open data / open source, UAVs, forestry, geomarketing, land planning, remote sensing imagery, mines and geology, municipalities, smart cities, mobility, Plan Nord, augmented reality, tracking, security, technological showcase, web 2.0, and 3D.

However, don't hesitate to submit your proposals on other themes, provided they are related to geomatics. The presentations will be time-boxed between 20 and 25 minutes, question time included.

Selection criteria

Members of the organizing committee of EnvisionGeomatics 2014 will evaluate and select the potential presentations based on the following criteria :

1. The interest and the relevance towards the themes highlighted by the committee.
2. The clearness of the subject and the underlying goals
3. The originality of the content (presentations with an original content will be favored)
4. The quality of the presentation.

An extra attention will be paid to reflect the diversity of players in the field of geomatics.

Requirements for applying

Each proposal for a presentation will be emailed to the organizing committee at : kjean@cgg.qc.ca. The deadline is 2014, June 27. In order to submit, you will have to fill in the registration form and send it before the deadline.

The following pieces of information will be required :

1. Last name and first name;
2. The contact information (name of the company, employer, phone,email address, address);
3. A short biography (max 70 words);
4. The title of the presentation;
5. The description of the presentation (max 250 words)

If your proposal is selected, you agree to fill in the comprehensive form that will be sent to you.
